Business Administration Minor for Non-Business Majors

Students who have declared their major into a non-business field may earn a minor in Business Administration.

To declare a minor in Business Administration, students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.25 or above.

¹ Business electives may be chosen from any of the following disciplines: Accounting, CMIS, Economics, Finance, Management, Marketing, Production, GBA, and Management Science. Students may not use CMIS 108 and MS 250 toward their minor requirements. Students must meet all published prerequisites to enroll in business courses.

- Minimum 21 hours required, maximum of 30 hours allowed;
- ✤ 12 hours for the minor must be earned at SIUE;
- To earn the minor, students must maintain a 2.25 GPA in all business courses leading to the minor;
- College of Arts and Sciences economics majors may not use ECON 111, 112 or any ECON course in the hours required for a Business minor;
- Students may consult with Business Advisors and/or faculty as they choose their business electives;
- Students must meet course prerequisite requirements for all courses taken for the minor;
