SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY

Southern Illinois University (SIU) System is comprised of two sister institutions: SIU Carbondale, with a School of Medicine in Springfield; and SIU Edwardsville, with a School of Dental Medicine in Alton and the SIUE East St. Louis Center in East St. Louis.

With a budget of approximately \$897 million, the SIU System employs more than 7,500 faculty, staff and administrators who serve nearly 32,000 students. A modern and comprehensive post-secondary educational system, the SIU System offers a broad range of academic programs that lead to associate, bachelor's, master's, specialist, doctoral and professional practice degrees in a variety of fields, including law, medicine, pharmacy, and dental medicine.

SIU Carbondale was chartered in 1869 as Southern Illinois Normal University, a teachers' college. In 1947, the name was changed to reflect the institution's academic expansion. The University also expanded geographically. As early as 1949,

courses were being offered in the metropolitan East St. Louis area, which led to the development of SIUE.

The instructional, scholarship and service missions of the two constituent institutions reflect the needs of the geographic areas in which they are located. The SIU System is also committed to serving state-wide, national and international needs. This commitment is reflected in educational activities and outreach in communities throughout the state, as well as through research and training exchanges and world-wide student exchange programs.

The SIU Board of Trustees governs the SIU System and sets policy that enables both universities to carry out their established missions and goals. The president of the System is its CEO and reports to the board of trustees. The University chancellors report directly to the president and are responsible for the internal operations of SIUE and SIUC, respectively.

Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (SIUE) traces its origin to a recommendation made in 1956 by the Southwest Illinois Council for Higher Education. The Council was convinced that higher education facilities were needed in the Metro East. They hired consultants whose reports documented that need, and they appealed to Southern Illinois University (SIU), 100 miles south, to establish satellite campuses.

In 1957, SIU opened two "residence centers" in Alton and East St. Louis. The University expected to enroll 800 students, but actual enrollment reached 1,776. By 1959, the number of students had more than doubled to 3,800, greatly exceeding the capabilities of the physical facilities. This burgeoning population demanded services faster than the University could develop and supply them.

A planning team investigated sites in the Metro East counties and selected one just south of Edwardsville. In 1960, the Illinois legislature authorized a bond issue for construction of a new state university campus. Voter approval came in November 1960. After nearly three years of planning, University officials and area residents attended ground-breaking ceremonies for the first permanent buildings.

In the fall of 1965, SIUE moved onto its new campus just 25 miles from St. Louis—2,660 acres of rolling land and woods dotted with lakes along bluffs flanking the Mississippi River. Much of the land still retains its natural shape. The core comprehensive university with nearly 14,000 students enrolled.

U.S. News & World Report Best Colleges of 2018 lists SIUE among the best Regional Universities Midwest for the 14th consecutive year and among the top 15 public universities in that category. The overall scores are based on the reputation of SIUE in higher education, graduate and retention rates, faculty resources, student selectivity, financial resources, and alumni giving. SIUE is ranked 11th in the country among the safest college campuses according to the National Council for Home Safety and Security. More than half of SIUE's 100,000

graduates live and work in the St. Louis region. SIUE makes more than a \$514 million economic impact on the region every year.

The University offers undergraduate and graduate areas of study encompassing the arts, sciences, nursing, education, health, human behavior, business and engineering. The Schools of Dental Medicine and Pharmacy award first professional doctoral degrees in dental medicine (DMD) and in pharmacy (PharmD). Doctoral degrees are available in nursing practice and educational leadership. Cooperative PhD programs in history, environmental resources and policy, engineering science, and computer science are offered with SIU Carbondale. The Edwardsville campus is enhanced by campuses in East St. Louis and Alton.

At SIUE, students find comprehensive educational opportunities and a community in which individuals support each other in their search for knowledge and individual development.

School of Nursing

The School of Nursing offers an excellent learning environment, which prepares students for a career as a professional nurse. The School's undergraduate and graduate programs are fully accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE), which means SIUE nursing students can be assured of receiving the highest quality education. The School partners with hundreds of health care agencies in Central and Southern Illinois and the St. Louis region to provide students with quality clinical practicum sites. Students also practice required nursing skills in the School's Simulated Learning Center to promote critical thinking and safe care before encountering patients in actual clinical settings. The undergraduate program is offered at both the Edwardsville and Carbondale campuses. Graduate programs include two master's degrees (nurse educator, and health care and nursing administration) and three doctoral degrees (a post-master's doctor of nursing practice DNP); and two post-baccalaureate DNP programs with specializations in nurse anesthesia and family nurse practitioner.

School of Pharmacy Gireesh V. Gupchup, Dean

The School of Pharmacy, the only pharmacy program in southern Illinois, offers a professional program leading to the Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) and Master of Science in pharmaceutical sciences. Established in 2005, the School graduated its first class in May 2009 and is fully accredited by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education. Our graduates enter a wide variety of professional settings, including community pharmacies, hospitals, the pharmaceutical industry and academia. SIUE pharmacy students work alongside other health professionals. This team approach allows health care professionals to optimize drug therapy and offer the highest quality of patient care.

School of Dental Medicine Bruce Rotter, Dean

The Southern Illinois University School of Dental Medicine is proud of its established tradition of graduating well-prepared general practitioners of dental medicine. Since 1972, the School has continued to carry out its mission to improve the oral health of southern Illinois and the region through education, patient care, scholarship and service. Through the care provided at the University's main clinic in Alton and the community clinics in East St. Louis and Edwardsville, as well as through its community outreach programs, the School serves as a vital oral health care provider for residents of southern and central Illinois, and the St. Louis metropolitan region.

Graduate School Jerry Weinberg, Dean

The National Science Foundation lists SIUE among the top 20 master's granting institutions in the U.S. in terms of research and development expenditures. The SIUE Graduate School offers more than 100 areas of study with master's, post-baccalaureate certificates and doctoral degrees in a variety of disciplines. Students prepare for the challenges of their profession in a rich, intellectual learning environment emphasizing research and practice.

Library and Information Services Lydia Jackson, Interim Dean

Library and Information Services provides information resources and technology for teaching, learning and scholarship. Information resources are available in all formats with a strong preference given to digital collections which are heavily accessed by users. Lovejoy Library is a member of CARLI (Consortium of Academic and Research Libraries in Illinois) which provides SIUE users full access to the holdings of the 128 CARLI libraries that share a catalog of millions of item records. Along with access to OCLC's WorldCat, with more than two billion items held by participating libraries, Lovejoy Library opens the world to SIUE users. Library resources are available through social media, its mobile website, 3D scanning and printing, and traditional methods. As in all successful 21st century academic libraries, library faculty are subject specialists who provide information literacy and technology instruction. They assist SIUE faculty in identifying and selecting open access materials, publishing research locally, and curating collections in our institutional repository, known as SPARK.

HONORARY DEGREE: VAUGHN VANDEGRIFT, PhD



Vaughn Vandegrift, PhD, committed 38 years of service to higher education with stops at Illinois State University, Murray State University, Montclair State University, Georgia Southern University, and finally, Southern Illinois University Edwardsville.

As the chancellor of SIUE from 2004-2012, he was a catalyst for change. His vision for SIUE was to be nationally recognized as a premier University for the excellence of its programs, and development of professional and community leaders.

Under his leadership, SIUE experienced significant growth as he spearheaded more than \$300 million in infrastructure and building projects, including the construction of a new residence hall, Evergreen Hall; the Science Building Complex; Student Success Center; Lukas Annex; the School of Dental Medicine Laboratory; the School of Pharmacy building; and renovations to the Vadalabene Center, Engineering Building, and Art and Design Building.

With his focus on the University competing nationally, he transitioned SIUE to NCAA Division I intercollegiate athletics with memberships in the Ohio Valley, Missouri Valley and Southern Conferences.

Academically, Vandegrift led development of several new degree programs, including a master's program in industrial engineering, doctoral programs in educational leadership and nursing practice, and a dual diploma program with Istanbul Technical University. His also established a University-wide advising plan, organized the Undergraduate Research and Creative Activities program, and developed a new general education plan.

The chancellor was also essential in branding SIUE. He led a marketing initiative to develop and promote the lowercase red "e" at SIUE as our University's hallmark.

In fall 2011, the chancellor announced that SIUE had attained record enrollment with 14,235 students. This record was surpassed in fall 2015 with the enrollment of 14,265 students. This is a testament that his efforts in promoting SIUE to higher levels of academic excellence are still being felt.

Outside of the University, Vandegrift served the St. Louis metropolitan area through involvement on several boards. He was a member and past president of Leadership Council Southwestern Illinois. Additionally, he served as a member of St. Louis Civic Progress, Innovate St. Louis, St. Louis Regional Chamber, United Way of Greater St. Louis and the Southern Illinois Collegiate Common Market.

Vandegrift has been honored with numerous awards, including the St. Louis Business Journal Influential St. Louisan award (2006-2012); the 2011 Lewis and Clark Council: Boy Scouts of America Distinguished Citizen award; the 2009 Freedom Fund Higher Education Leadership Award; Leadership Council Southwestern Illinois awards in 2007, 2010 and 2012; and the 2012 Edwardsville/Glen Carbon Chamber of Commerce Synergy Award.

The chancellor now resides in Florida with his wife, Sue. He is the proud parent to three adult children, Beth, David and Mark, and has seven grandchildren.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD: SENATOR WILLIAM "BILL" HAINE



William "Bill" Haine is the senator for the Illinois 56th Senate district, which covers most of Madison County, including Alton, Wood River, Edwardsville and part of O'Fallon.

Senator Haine has committed his entire adult life to serving the public. In 1967, immediately after receiving his bachelor's degree from Saint Louis University (SLU), he enlisted in the United States Army. He served until 1969 and earned a Bronze Star for his combat service as a member of the 1st Cavalry Division during the Vietnam War.

In 1978, nearly 10 years after his military service ended, and four years after receiving his juris doctor degree from SLU, his career in politics began after he was elected to the Madison County Board. He went on to serve 14 years as Madison County state's attorney until 2002, when he was elected to the State Senate.

Senator Haine has been a champion for issues for working-class families throughout the region, including numerous efforts to bring jobs into his district, rallying for key infrastructure upgrades to the Metro East levee system and Interstate 255, and formally demanding that Congress and the President review the national tariff policy on steel goods when U.S. Steel in Granite City announced it was going to close.

The Senator has also been a trailblazer for statewide issues of insurance and criminal law while keeping an eye on the communities he represents.

A true advocate of Southern Illinois University Edwardsville and other institutions across the state of Illinois, he fought against potential cuts to higher education funding in the Senate. He was one of SIUE's strongest supporters in the Senate during the state budget crisis. Aside from advocating for the University, he also served on the Dean's Advisory Board for the SIU School of Dental Medicine.

The Senator's passion for serving both his local community and his country sparked his involvement in several organizations, including the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the American Legion Post 204, where he is a past commander; Knights of Columbus; and the Alton Cemetery Board of Trustees.

Throughout his career, the Senator has shown a deep commitment to pushing the state forward and stimulating growth throughout the region. Though his term in office is slated to come to a close in January 2019, the impact he has made on this University, our region and the state will be seen well into the future.

Senator Haine and his wife, Anna, live in Alton. They have seven children—five daughters and two sons—and 32 grandchildren.

TEACHING EXCELLENCE AWARD: SANDRA WEISSINGER, PhD



Sandra Weissinger, PhD, is an assistant professor of sociology and graduate program director in the SIUE College of Arts and Sciences. She joined the Department of Sociology in 2012.

The Teaching Excellence Award committee praised Weissinger for representing all the qualities and characteristics of an exceptional educator, noting her ability to bring delicate topics on race, class, gender and sexual orientation into classroom discussion with sensitivity and professionalism.

"Dr. Weissinger impressed us with her utilization of practical, real-world examples within her teaching style, while keeping students actively engaged as her enthusiasm and passion shine through to the students," said Kelly Gable, PharmD, associate professor in the SIUE School of Pharmacy and Teaching Excellence Award committee

chair. "She is an inspirational teacher who encourages her students to dig deeply and think critically about current events."

Weissinger's teaching areas include African American communities, race and ethnic relations, urban sociology, and qualitative research methods. Her research interests focus on African American communities and institutions, inequality, and intragroup marginalization. She was the lead editor of two books, *Law Enforcement in the Age of Black Lives Matter* and *Violence Against Black Bodies*.

HISTORY OF ACADEMIC REGALIA

The pageantry of the academic procession is used for many of the formal and significant events at SIUE.

Inherited from the medieval universities of the 11th and 12th centuries when woolen gowns and hoods were worn by scholars for warmth in unheated quarters, the wearing of academic vestments and the procession were not adopted throughout the United States until the late 19th century.

Academic life in the Middle Ages began first in the church, then in the guilds. The teaching guild was the guild of the master of arts, where the bachelor was the apprentice of the master and the dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility, designed to distinguish the wearer from the merchants and other townsmen.

Principal features of academic dress are the gown, cap and hood. Both Cambridge and Oxford Universities, since the 15th century, have made academic dress a matter of university control, even to its minor details, and have repeatedly published revised regulations. American universities agreed on a definite system in 1894. In 1932, the American Council on Education presented a revised code which, for the most part, governs the style of academic dress today.

The cap worn almost universally in academic processions is the Oxford cap, better known as the mortarboard. From poetry we learn that the

cap of scholarship was square to symbolize a book. A different style, called the Cambridge cap, resembles a large beret.

The use of a dark hood in academic processions is thought to have arisen from the clerical practice of wearing a cap or mantle in religious processions during the 12th and 13th centuries, when universities arose from cathedral schools. Traditionally, gowns are also black. In recent years, however, a number of universities have adopted other hues which signify the school's traditional colors, such as crimson for Harvard, blue for Yale, purple for Northwestern, orange "hash marks" for Princeton, maize with azure blue chevron for the University of Michigan, maroon for the University of Chicago, and cardinal and gold for the University of Southern California. The bachelor's gown is a yoked, closed-front garment with long, pointed sleeves. The master's has long, closed sleeves slit just above the elbow, permitting the forearms to protrude. The doctor's has full, bell-shaped sleeves and is trimmed with velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on each sleeve. The color of the panels and sleeves varies to indicate the doctoral field.

The academic hoods, worn around the neck and down the back of the gown, are lined with the official colors of the college or university conferring the degree. The binding or edging of the hood usually represents the subject of the degree.

Mace

The SIUE ceremonial mace was created in 1981 by the late Michael E. Mason. He earned both a Bachelor of Arts and Master of Fine Arts from SIUE and served as curator of the University Museum. At that time, the president of SIUE (the position now called chancellor) Earl Lazerson instituted traditional, formal regalia for use on significant ceremonial occasions. In 2005, Chancellor Vaughn Vandegrift restored the tradition of the mace at all commencement and other academic ceremonies. A stand was subsequently constructed and, in recognition of the values of the University, engraved brass plaques were added to the ceremonial mace with the words Citizenship, Excellence, Inclusion, Integrity and Wisdom.

PROGRAM RECOGNITION

The SIUE School of Nursing offers dynamic undergraduate programs of study that are both theoretical and practical, designed to meet current and future challenges of nursing and healthcare. The School's fully accredited programs prepare graduates to work in a wide variety of clinical settings and provide the necessary foundation for a master's and doctoral degree in nursing.

The *traditional bachelor of science in nursing (BS)* program is intended for students seeking their first degree with no prior college experience. This option is offered at the SIUE campus and through the SIUE Regional Nursing Program on the SIU Carbondale campus.

The post-baccalaureate accelerated bachelor of science degree in nursing (ABS) option allows students with a bachelor's degree to attain a BS degree in nursing through three semesters and one summer session. It is an intense, defined curriculum with a combination of classroom instruction and clinical experiences for students seeking a second baccalaureate degree.

Registered nurses (*RNs*) who hold an associate degree in nursing or a nursing diploma can pursue the RN to BS option. This baccalaureate program is offered in a flexible, entirely online format to accommodate the needs of working RNs. The program format consists of eight-week courses and can be completed in one year if most of the general education requirements are met at the time of admission.

The goal of the SIUE School of Nursing graduate program is to prepare expert nurses for leadership in professional nursing practice and patient-centered health care delivery. The School of Nursing offers two masters programs and a doctor of nursing practice degree (DNP) with three specializations.

The fully online *MS* in *Health Care and Nursing Administration (HCNA)* program prepares nurses for entry into management positions in health care organizations, and refines the skills of experienced nurse managers to mentor them for executive-level positions. The *MS* in nurse educator program is also provided in an online format. There is an ever-increasing need for nursing faculty, and our nurse educator students are actively sought throughout the St. Louis metropolitan region, as well as nationally.

The *nurse anesthesia DNP specialization* prepares registered nurses with baccalaureate degrees to provide individualized anesthetic patient care for surgical, diagnostic, therapeutic or pain management procedures. The *family nurse practitioner DNP specialization* program provides students with the required clinical competencies and theoretical foundation to deliver quality primary care for patients and their families. The *post-master's DNP* program is designed for nurses holding a master's degree as an advanced practice nurse, or holding a bachelor's of science in nursing and a master's degree appropriate to their advance nursing practice role.

Hooding is a special recognition for doctoral candidates during which the Dean of the School of Pharmacy places the doctoral hood upon the shoulders of each graduate, signifying his or her success in completing the pharmacy program. Hooding allows students to share the accomplishment of earning the professional doctorate with family, friends and the School of Pharmacy faculty and staff.

A tradition dating to the Middle Ages, the olive green velvet facing of the hood denotes the wearer's pharmacy discipline. The red and white color of the lining represents the institution from which the degree was awarded, in this case Southern Illinois University Edwardsville. The velvet tam, rather than the traditional mortarboard cap, is commonly worn by doctorate holders.
