


Why Important?

•Students make connections and network with local lawyers, judges, and legal professionals.

•Pre-Law Internship assists with recruitment of new students to Pre-Law and SIUE.

• SIUE work with community partners (Madison County Courthouse; Illinois Justice Corps; St. Clair County State's



Problem: Lacking Experiential Learning Access

The Pre-Law Program has, over the past 7 years, experienced a renaissance. It now boasts:

- Active Pre-Law Association for students;
- Pre-Law Interdisciplinary Minor; and
- Pre-Law Mentor program.

However, it **lacked** <u>experiential learning opportunities for</u> <u>students</u>. Such opportunities would allow students to:

- •Assess whether law school is the right choice.
- •Learn what life is like in a law firm.
- •Decide if this career path, given the high cost of a legal education, is their passion.

Solution: Create Legal Internships

- EUE Grant submitted & approved to create Pre-Law Program Internship.
- Identify Madison and St Clair Counties law firms and legal professionals.
- Work with Madison and St Clair County Bar Associations to identify contact information.
- Create SIUE Pre-Law Program Internship Agreement and cover letter for mailings.
- Mailings completed to over 700 law firms, agencies, and legal offices.
- Establish Excel database of participating firms and programs, once signed Agreement received by SIUE.



New Course: CJ 398.500

EUE WORK PRODUCT:

- •Created Syllabus, Form 90 and Form 94 submitted and approved for **Fall 2016**.
- •Students journal field notes.
- •Students compare their expectations with the internship experience.
- •Students earn 3 hours credit for 150 hrs onsite.
