## Study Methods

The study population consists of students who declared a graduate major in Academic Year 2007-08 or later. The study includes any student working toward a Master's degree, Education Specialist (Ed.S.), Doctorate, or Doctor of Professional Practice in Pharmacy. Certificate programs (P.B., P.M., S.D.) are not included at this time. Students were assigned into program cohorts based on the year in which they declared and first enrolled in the major. The study follows students in program cohorts for academic years 2007-08 through 2020-21. Students were tracked within their cohorts to determine the program graduation and retention rates in the major for Year 2, Year 4, and Year 6 from the academic year of declaration. Graduation rates displayed are cumulative, i.e. the rate for Year 6 includes students counted for the Year 4 and Year 2 rates. The SIUE Graduation rate at Year 6 includes students in the program graduation rate plus students who changed majors and were awarded an SIUE graduate-level degree in a different program. The retention rates are based on retention in the year displayed only, and students included in the graduation rate are not also included in the retention rate. The credit hours required to graduate for each program are from the Graduate catalog.

**NOTES:**

Cohorts are based on the academic year (or fall term for Pharm.D.) in which students declare their major.

Completion years are through Summer of the time period indicated, for instance students in Fall cohort 2007 are followed through Summer 2009 to determine the Year 2 graduation rate.

Students are considered retained if they were enrolled in any one of the Summer, Fall, or Spring terms in the year displayed, and are not included in the graduation rate for that year.
