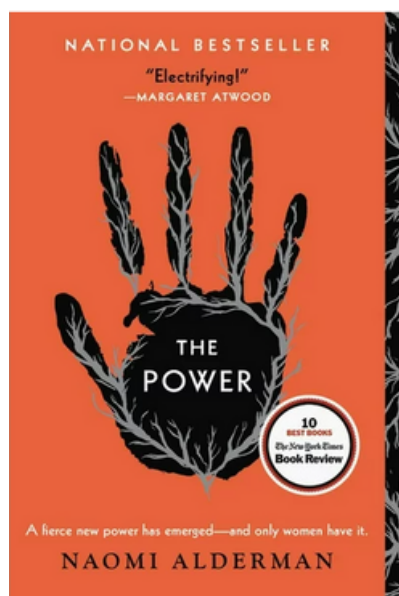
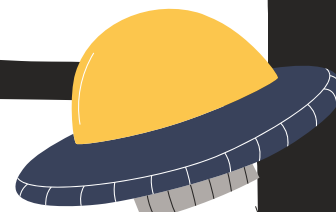

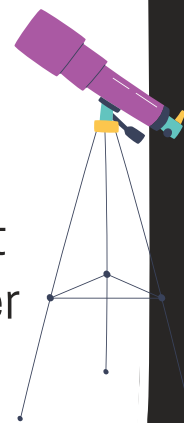
SPACE MONTH
