Congrats, 2020 Graduates!



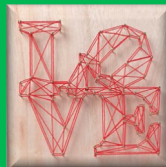
On May 15 at 1:00 p.m.,

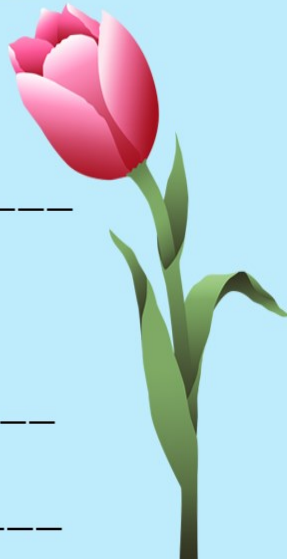
