CDC Vaccination Schedules	 Gives vaccine recommendations for different ages and conditions. Provides contraindications for immunizations. Catch-up recommendations provided 	
PneumoRecs VaxAdvisor	 Helps providers quickly assess if patient is in need of pneumonia vaccine based on age and underlying medical conditions 	
CDC Opioid Guidelines	 Morphine milliequivalents conversion Link to CDC opioid guidelines Recommendations for patients on opioids
