

Kaskaskia College Associate in Arts ART HISTORY

Completion of an Associate in Arts or Science degree at Kaskaskia College fulfills SIUE's general education requirements, with the exception of an Interdisciplinary Studies course that all students must take during their junior and senior year at SIUE.

This "Transfer Program Guide" is an **example** of proposed curriculum for students to use while completing their associate's degree. Reading, writing and math placement could alter the course sequencing and transfer date. Therefore students should begin sequencing their reading/writing (if applicable) and math & science courses during the first semester, paying close attention to prerequisites. Students have the option of taking summer classes to lessen fall and spring course loads.

It is highly recommended that students meet with a KC advisor each semester. Please see "Important Student Notes" located on page of two of this transfer guide.

Students are advised to meet on a regular basis with advisors at KC. Courses taken through dual credit can be applied to required SIUE coursework; please contact KC advisor for more information. Please consult Kaskaskia College catalog for additional graduation requirements.

Students are required to complete a Bachelor of Arts degree. A Bachelor of Arts degree will require 2 semesters of the same foreign language, which can be taken at either KC or SIUE, in addition to 8 Humanities and/or Fine Arts Courses (some of which will be completed with the Associate in Arts.)

Students majoring in Art History can elect to apply to the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) degree after compiling a portfolio of SIUE artwork. It is highly recommended that students visit their KC advisor for information.

DECLARATION REQUIREMENTS FOR A BACHELOR OF ARTS

An overall GPA of 2.5 in transferable work

A minor is required for students who major in Art History. Options for a double major, double minor, or a single minor are available. Courses taken at KC to meet KC's general education requirements can be used for the minor(s) or additional major. Students should begin planning early for any of these options.
