**Brief description of the nature of the research/creative activity?**

The student will be working with me on research activities related to the concept of cultural humility and nurse well-being in healthcare. Populations may include students, faculty, nursing professionals, and individuals interested in short term global health experiences. Activities may include: assisting with literature review, development of a tool or intervention to assess well being, draft in preparation for IRB submission, compiling and collaborating on analysis of data, assistance with dissemination of findings, and exploring additional funding opportunities.

**Brief description of student responsibilities?**

Student responsibilities include completing CITI training, assisting with recruitment and training of interventions on scholarly work/creative activities, data collection, data entry, collaborating on review of data and developing a poster or powerpoint presentation to disseminate findings. May include review of poster, podium presentation and/or manuscript.
